Supporting Success

In MAC South students are supported to integrate into KLA successfully through interventions, family support and bespoke reintegration packages for students who have been out of school long-term.

Some students will access MAC South when they have been removed from a lesson for disruption.

MAC North:

KS3 students who need additional support to successfully manage mainstream lessons.

Students will be taught English, Maths, Science and Personal Development in a small group with senior staff support.

Students will access the main school for all other subjects.

Students will be offered a breakfast at the start of the day and will carry a report card to lesson.

Students will have allocated seats and an allocated laptop to work on.

Where students are successful they will be supported to reintegrate into the main school.
