

Proposed scheme to expand Kings Lynn Academy

Plans to increase to an 8 Form Entry Secondary School

Dear Neighbour,

As part of Norfolk County Council's commitment to invest in the growth of secondary education provision we are proposing an exciting new expansion at Kings Lynn Academy which will provide an additional 300 pupil places.

A design team from NPS Property Consultants Ltd has been working closely with the Academy and Norfolk County Council on possible solutions and we anticipate submitting a planning application in late November 2023, and before we do so we would like to share the proposal with parents and local residents.

The scheme will be comprised of a new CDT building and expansion of the existing kitchen, dining and library facilities.

The proposal will also allow existing space within the current building to be reconfigured providing additional spaces for Art, Creative Media and general classroom accommodation.

Children's Services will be holding an informal exhibition event on Tuesday 4th July at Kings Lynn Academy, Queen Mary Road, Kings Lynn, PE30 4QG, between 4:00pm and 6:00pm. This is an open event, and no booking is necessary.

Representatives from NPS Property Consultants, Norfolk County Council and the Academy will be available to answer questions you may have about the plans.

Please be aware that these plans are subject to change. Please check the Norfolk County Council Planning website once the full application has been submitted. Once the planning application has been submitted there will be the opportunity for individuals and interested parties to express their views to the planning authority as a formal submission.

If approved, it is hoped work will start July 2024, and have an approximate 12 month build duration.
